

In the past decade, there have been significant advancements made towards the UN goal of ending paediatric AIDS by 2030:3

- the rate of new HIV infections in children has declined by 52% since 20101
- 53% of children living with HIV have access to treatment¹
- 85% of pregnant women living with HIV had access to ARTs to prevent transmission of HIV to their child in 2019.1


