

Viiv Healthcare's Amp grants: Fueling grassroots change and leaders

ViiV Healthcare's **Positive Action AMP Grant** initiative funds community-led organizations to incubate and support emerging efforts to disrupt disparities in HIV care. These three-year incubators serve as resource hubs and think tanks for leaders, networks and projects, providing micro-grants, mentorship and other network supports.

ViiV Healthcare's AMP Grant initiative is a new way to resource grassroots networks and projects that typically can't access funding by supporting community organizations to make micro-grants. These resources fund emerging linkage to care, advocacy and network-building projects across the United States as they work to expand outreach and engagement in prevention and care.

AMP Grant Leads are organizations that have a deep knowledge of community needs and strong relationships with emerging and frontline leaders. They develop calls for proposals and identify top talent to redistribute funding. **AMP Grant Micro-Grantees** gain access to funds that were not previously accessible through the re-granting process. They develop their skills through coaching and technical assistance, build connections to a larger network and implement innovative projects.
